Field Work Day Friday 27th September

The whole school will be taking part in Field work at different times across the day; this will include an aspect of map skills. Some classes will be using the school grounds for their fieldwork (including Early Years), whilst others will be exploring our local school community (including Year 2) or Leavesden Park (Year 3). We will have a school assembly at the end of the day to showcase what the classes have been learning. We will make sure to take some photos to share on our website and social media pages.

This will be our first themed week this academic year where we aim to demonstrate a cross-curricular approach to learning. As part of the week each class will be creating a piece of artwork based on an important person. For this we need your help-

- Nursery and Reception class need a photograph/ printed image of someone who helps us e.g. fire fighter, police officer, doctor, dentist.
- Year 1 and 2 need a photograph/printed image of an important person who lives in Hertfordshire.
- Year 3 and 4 need a photograph/ printed image of an important person in British History.
- Year 5 and 6 need a photograph/printed image of an important person in World History.
