- Recites some numbers in sequence
- Explore numbers 1-5
- Selects a number of objects from a group, when asked is able to give one/two
- Notices shapes in pictures/patterns

## Understanding of the World

- All about me exploring how we are all different looking at ourselves/family and likes
- Friendships/Kindness/Sharing
- People who help us

## Physical Development

### Fine Motor Skills

- Develop skills for cutting
- Explore threading
- Daily busy fingers activities to develop fine motor skills

## Nursery Autumn

### All About Me

#### Personal, Social, Emotional

- Able to talk about their own preferences
- Develop confidence to talk to peers/adults
- Learn to share/take turns
- Able to express feelings such as happy/sad
- Learn to play with peers extending the game for others to join

#### Physical Development

##### Gross Motor skills

- Move freely in a range of ways such as slithering, rolling, jumping, skipping, sliding, crawling
- Work with sports coach hand and eye coordination

## Literacy -Reading

- Learns to handle books and printed material with care
- To explore new songs and rhymes
- Share a story repeating simple phrases from familiar stories
- To develop listening skills in the environment

## Literacy - writing

- Activities to develop hand strength
- Sometimes to give meaning to marks they have made.

## Expressive Arts and Designs

- Explore paints/pens creating simple mark making skills/pictures
- Exploring colour-mixing for a purpose.
- To build a repertoire of songs/Rhymes
- To explore different types of instruments sounds
