



Code of Conduct for Children Staff, Parents/Carers, Governors and all Visitors to Alban Wood

At Alban Wood, we value:

RESPECT KINDNESS AMBITION

We have high expectations of the entire community and believe that as well as the children always striving to achieve these values, all adults should be a model of them in our everyday behaviours and interactions. The following is a practical outline of the code of conduct that is expected of everybody at school:

- Respect for one another will be shown through mutual co-operation and politeness at all times
- Respect for the school property and our environment will be shown through care taken and thoughtfulness on site
- Respect for the children and their learning, will always be a number one priority for use all

As such the following will **not** be acceptable and may result in any adult being escorted from the premises:

- Shouting, swearing or any level of verbal abuse (and especially any language which is prejudiced in any way)
- Threatening or physical behaviour which may result in damage to any other human or school property (this includes an expectation that there will be no littering or smoking on site)
- Bullying or ongoing unkindness which may make any member of the Alban Wood community feel unwelcome or discriminated against

This code of conduct exists to ensure that we all operate in a happy, safe, secure community, which is what our children fully deserve.
