



Year 1 Home Learning Grid Autumn 1 2016

<p>Maths 1: Go on a 3D shape hunt. Can you find any cubes, cuboids, spheres or triangular prisms? Draw or take a photograph of the things that you find.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Challenge: Can you find any different 3D shapes that are not already listed above?</p>	<p>Writing 1: Make a dinosaur fact file. Write about one (or more) dinosaurs. What did it eat? How big was it? What were its teeth like? Where did it like to live? Etc You could present it as an illustrated little book or a poster.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you find a modern animal which is similar to the dinosaur you have written about? How is it similar?</p>	<p>Science : We are learning about humans and our senses. Think about the sense of touch. Try and find some things in your house, garden or woods which are: smooth, soft, bumpy, rough, hard, scratchy, warm, cold or furry. Draw a picture of each thing, or print out a photo, and label it in your book. E.g. My cat is furry.</p> <p>Challenge: Hide an object in a bag and see if your family can guess what it is.</p>	<p>Topic: Dinosaurs! Thank you for the amazing holiday homework you have already done! A new task is to make a dinosaur alphabet- can you find a dinosaur for every letter of the alphabet? Write them in order in your book, with a picture you have drawn/traced or printed.</p> <p>Challenge: Invent your own dinosaur, with a new name for any missing letters!</p>
