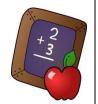


English: We have read The Twits where the horrid couple play pranks on each other. Write a set of instructions to show the prank you would pull on Mr and Mrs Twit.

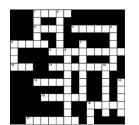
