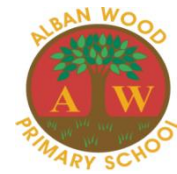


Year 3 Home Learning Grid Autumn 1-Food and Feasts



Choose one home learning activity each week. You can choose which one to do and in which order you do them.
