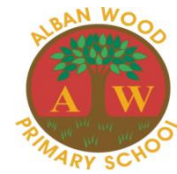





## Year 3 Home Learning Grid Autumn 2-Food and Feasts
