<p>Creating a setting. Imagine you are a film scriptwriter. Create a mountain setting for an adventure film, Write a description of your set using expanded noun phrases. Remember to appeal to the senses and create an atmosphere of danger and adventure! Do NOT write any action! You are a scientist and have the chance to go into space. What would you want to find out? What might you take with you? What would you hope to achieve?
