<p>Visit the local library or use the internet to find information about the clothing of peasants during Shakespeare's time. Draw and dress a man and a woman of that class. Include a range of adjectives to label. Draw a poster illustrating important events in Shakespeare's life from birth to death- remember to include the dates! You may cut some of the text, but the comic book should cover the entire play and Shakespeare's language should basically remain intact.
