Choose one home learning activity each week. You can choose which one to do and in which order you do them.

Parents/Carers please sign and date when your child has completed each task. For when you have a busy weekend we have included a Family Week. These are only suggestions of some things you might do and there is no need put anything in the homework book for the family week, unless you wish to. Just sign to show that is the activity chosen.

<p>Visit the local library or use the internet to find information about the lives of people in 1912. You can portray your information any way you like. Some ideas: a timeline, an information leaflet, a report or even a collection of illustrations.</p> <p>Challenge: How has England changed over the years? Write about how much the tickets cost, what's included in the price and how much spending money you would need to take for a week long holiday.
