Choose one home learning activity each week. You can choose which one to do and in which order you do them.

Parents/Carers please sign and date when your child has completed each task. For when you have a busy weekend we have included a Family Week. These are only suggestions of some things you might do and there is no need put anything in the homework book for the family week, unless you wish to. Just sign to show that is the activity chosen.

<p>Using the spellings in your reading diary, come up with a game that we can use during our spelling investigations. It should be suitable for four players and come with a clear set of instructions. Write about how much the flights cost, hotel prices, the currency needed and how much spending money a family of four would need to take for a week long holiday. <p>Plan a school trip to Cuffley Camp. You need to take 29 children and 3 adults. The coach costs £72.50 one way. For each child it is £15.00 to enter Cuffley. Adult prices are on offer: Buy one get one free! £22.50 per adult.</p> <p>How much will the trip cost in total?</p> <p>Challenge: Two new children have joined and so another adult now needs to come. You could use paper mache, plasticine, pens and pencils, paint, tissue paper- anything you like! Include as many of Japan's features as you can.
